## ASCP Policy on Communication

According to the ASCP Constitution (2021), the Society's communication activities consists in "maintaining and managing the Society's website ([www.ascp.org.au](http://www.ascp.org.au)), for the promotion of any Society events and activities, including the annual conference (in conjunction with the conference subcommittee), for ensuring that any material publicised via the Society's website accords with the rules and aims of the Society, and for maintaining the social media presence of the Society" (§7.1.7).

The ASCP will

- maintain effective communication with our members and prospective members
- manage its website ([www.ascp.org.au](http://www.ascp.org.au)) that presents the aims, and governance structure of the Society, and promotes the Society's activities such the annual conference
- engage social media to publicize the activities of the Society and our members
- facilitate communication about issues that concern the professional field of continental philosophy
- develop community guidelines to regulate use of the ASCP list and social media

The Communications Officer in the ASCP executive is responsible to:

- Develop and implement an action plan for communication
- Effectively promote the activities and initiatives of the Society
- Consult with members about effective Communication
- Oversee the implementation of the community guidelines
